Other key points of the last EC conference call (of 27.11.2020)

- Relapse strategy work continues to analyse the SIOPEN centre relapse regimen survey, develop a 1st relapse trial and a consolidation trial. Relapse group will be incorporated into the drug development committee.
- Primage project some centres have been requested to submit imaging data from HR-NBL1 participants. Some countries have concerns about consent and ethics committee approval. A document will be circulated to centres to support any request to local or national regulatory authorities.
- Restructure of biology group proposal to create a circulating biomarker committe with separate work streams is being prepared for consideration by EC&AB.
- Cancers special editions some SIOPEN members have been approached by Cancers to edit / submit article to a high-risk neuroblastoma special edition of Cancers. Further discussion between journal editors and SIOPEN are planned to explore and coordinate the approach further.
- **SIOPEN publication** Central nervous system relapses in patients with high-risk stage 4 properties in patients with high-risk stage 4 properties neuroblastoma: the SIOPEN/HR-NBL1 trial experience, Pablo Berlanga *et al.* Accepted by EJC and will be published soon (SIOPEN have supported and funded open access).
